ISSUE OF DUKETON MINING LIMITED SHARES – SECONDARY TRADING NOTICE NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 708A(5)(e) OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT 2001 ("Act")

On 4 April 2018, Duketon Mining Limited ("**Company**") issued 14,545,455 fully paid ordinary shares at an issue price of \$0.275 per share ("**Securities**").

Secondary Trading Exemption
